





Read the instructions, keep them safe, pass them on if you pass the appliance on. Remove all packaging before use.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Follow basic safety precautions, including:

- 1 This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been supervised/instructed and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be done by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised.
- Keep the appliance and cable out of reach of children under 8 years.
- A The surfaces of the appliance will get hot.
- 2 If you overfill, the kettle may spit boiling water.
- 3 Use the kettle only with the stand supplied (and vice versa).
- 4 If the cable is damaged, return the appliance, to avoid hazard.
- So Don't put the kettle, stand, cable, or plug in any liquid.
- 5 Keep the kettle, stand, and cable away from the edges of worktops.
- 6 Don't use the kettle for any purpose other than heating water.
- 7 Don't operate the appliance if it's damaged or malfunctions.

household use only

- After 5 minutes of inactivity, the appliance will go to sleep.
- Press any button to wake the appliance. All the buttons will flash.
- To save electricity, unplug the stand.

BEFORE USING FOR THE FIRST TIME

• Fill to max, boil, discard the water, then rinse. Do this three times, to remove manufacturing dust, etc.

FILLING

- 1 Remove the kettle from the stand.
- 2 Press the lid lock to open the lid.
- 3 Fill with at least 2 cups of water, but not above max.
- 4 Close the lid, and press down to lock it.

SWITCHING ON

- 5 Put the stand on a stable, level surface.
- 6 Plug the stand into the wall socket. All the buttons will flash.
- 7 Put the kettle on the stand.

VARIABLE TEMPERATURE

- 8 The temperatures available are: 100 (boil), 90 (coffee), 80, and 70 (that's °C).
- 9 Press the button marked with the temperature you want. The button will glow.
- 10 The colour of the status light will indicate the water temperature.

blue	green	purple	red
70°C	80°C	90°C	100°C

- a) If the water temperature is below 70°C, the status light will not glow.
- b) If the water temperature is already at or over the temperature you set, nothing will happen the water is ready to use.
- 11 The status light will flash till the water reaches the set temperature, then glow steadily.
- 12 The colour of the status light will change with the temperature of the water in the kettle.
- 13 When it reaches the set temperature, the light in the button will go off.
- 14 To switch off manually, press the button again.
- ✤ Reducing the temperature may take a long time you may prefer to pour the hot water away, and refill with cold water.

GENERAL

- 15 To avoid the risk of splashing, pour slowly and don't over-tilt the kettle.
- 16 You may see some discolouration on the floor of the kettle. Don't worry it's due to the bonding of the element to the kettle floor.

USING WITH INSUFFICIENT WATER

- 17 This will shorten the life of the element. A boil-dry cut-out will switch the kettle off.
- 18 To reset the cut-out, remove the kettle from the stand and leave it till it goes cold before replacing it on the stand.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 19 Unplug the stand, and let the kettle cool before cleaning.
- 20 Wipe the kettle, inside and out, with a damp cloth
- 21 Open the lid.
- 22 Push the hook on top of the filter down, then lift the filter out of the kettle.
- 23 Rinse the filter under a running tap while brushing with a soft brush.
- 24 Lower the filter into the kettle, and engage the bottom hook in the bottom of the spout.
- 25 Press the top of the filter towards the kettle, to lock the hook in place.

Descale regularly, (at least monthly).

- 26 Descale the appliance at least monthly with a proprietary descaler. Follow the instructions on the package of descaler.
- Products returned under guarantee with faults due to scale will be subject to a repair charge.

₿℃ OPTIMUM TEMPERATURES FOR TEAS AND COFFEES

The temperature of the water used in the preparation of different types of tea and coffee is important.

tea	water temperature °C	brewing time (min)
black tea	80 – 90	5 – 7
whole leaf black tea	80 – 90	4
broken leaf black tea	80 – 90	5
smoked tea	80 – 90	3 – 4
flavoured black tea	80	3 – 4
green tea	70 – 90	2 – 5
flavoured green tea	70 – 80	3 - 4
Sencha (Japanese green tea)	70	45 seconds to 1 minute (2.5g tea per 100ml water) or 2 minutes (3.5g tea per 100ml water)
Genmaicha (Japanese green tea)	90	2 – 3
wu long/oolong/blue/blue- green	80 – 90	about 7 minutes
yellow tea	70 – 80	2 - 4
white tea	70 – 80	7 to 20 minutes (4 to 5 infusions possible)
coffee		
instant coffee	90	
coffee (piston/plunger coffee pot)	90
