IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been supervised/instructed and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be done by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and cable out of reach of children under 8 years.
- 2 Always ensure the voltage to be used corresponds to the voltage stated on the unit before plugging the appliance into the mains socket.
- 3 Warning: Do not use this appliance near bathtubs, showers, basins or other vessels containing water.



- 4 When the appliance is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the appliance is switched off.
- 5 Do not wrap the cord around the unit. Check the cord regularly for any sign damage.
- 6 If the supply cord of this unit becomes damaged, discontinue use immediately and return the appliance to your nearest authorised Remington[®] service dealer for repair or replacement in order to avoid a hazard.
- 7 Do not use the appliance if it is damaged or malfunctions.
- 8 Do not allow any part of the appliance touch the face, neck or scalp.
- 9 Do not leave the appliance unattended while plugged in.
- 10 Only set the appliance down on a heat-proof surface.
- 11 Do not place the appliance on any soft furnishings.
- 12 Do not use attachments other than those we supply.
- 13 This appliance is not intended for commercial or salon use.
- 14 Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away.
- 15 Ensure rollers and heated clips are correctly placed on the heated rails not against the heated rail.
- 16 Always keep the lid closed while the rollers are heating.
- 17 Do not use on artificial hairpieces or wigs.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1 Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
- 2 For extra protection use a heat protection spray.
- Hairsprays contain flammable material do not use while using this product.
- 3 Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- 4 Plug the product into the mains power supply.
- CAUTION : the appliance will begin to heat-up as soon as the power supply is switched on.
- 5 The lid should be in the down position until the rollers are ready to use.
- 6 Rollers will be ready in 90 seconds. Allow 3 to 5 minutes for best results.
- 7 For the most efficient heating, place the large rollers on the first 3 heated bars.
- 8 When you feel your setters are ready, open the lid for 1 minute and begin use.

🔅 TO CURL

- 9 Select the desired size of roller. Use the medium rollers for tighter curls; the larger rollers give looser curls and waves.
- 10 Take a section of hair, about the width of the roller.
- 11 Wrap the ends of the hair around the roller, keeping the hair at right angles to the scalp.
- 12 Wind the roller right down to the roots.
- 13 Secure the roller firmly in place with the clips as near to the scalp as possible.
- 14 Repeat with the next section of hair.
- 15 Leave all the rollers in the hair until the rollers and hair have fully cooled down and set the style.
- ✤ Note: Use fixing spray to help set and keep your style for longer
- 16 For a soft, wavy curl, use the rollers for only a couple of minutes. For a tighter curl, leave the rollers in the hair for 5-10 minutes.
- 17 Rollers will remain actively curling for approximately 15 minutes.
- 18 Remove the rollers from your hair by removing each clip and gently unwinding.
- 19 Let the curl spring back into place and leave the hair to cool fully before styling to ensure the optimum set.

✤ FOR VOLUME

- 20 Use the large rollers provided.
- 21 Roll the top, front layer of the hair back to your crown, using one roller.

- 22 Next, use three other rollers to roll the remaining hair in three equal sections on the back and sides of the head.
- 23 Roll the hair under, up the nape of the neck.

✤ FLICKED OUT

- 24 Use the large rollers provided.
- 25 Roll the hair back and under to the crown to give height.
- 26 Take large sections all around the sides of your head and roll up so the hair will flip out.
- 27 You should roll the rollers up to the level of the top of your ear. Leave the rollers in place for approximately ten minutes.
- 28 Unroll the rollers in the order that you put them in, let the curl cool for a minute to set.
- 29 Next, brush your hair out, using your hands to shape the flip outward.
- 30 Unplug the unit after you have used all the rollers you need.
- 31 Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the appliance and allow to cool.
- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
