

### HAIR DRYFR - INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Wash and condition your hair as normal.
- 2. Squeeze out excess moisture with a towel and comb through.
- Hairsprays contain flammable material do not use while using this product. 3
- Plug the product into the mains power supply. 4.
- To switch the product on slide the speed setting switch up once to the medium 5. speed setting **X**.
- Select the desired temperature and speed setting using the switch on the handle. 6
- 7. To select heat setting slide the temperature setting switch to the low ( or high setting \.
- 8. For fast drving use the high heat / high speed function.
- To create smooth styles use the concentrator and a round hair brush (not included) 9 whilst drying.
- 10. To set your style, press the cool shot button whilst styling then release it to reactivate the heat.
- 11. After use, turn the appliance off and unplug.
- 12. To turn off slide the speed setting switch down to the '0' position.
- 13. Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away.

#### Keep direct airflow away from eyes or other sensitive areas. .

- Do not allow any part of the appliance touch the face, neck or scalp.
- During use, always ensure the inlet and outlet grilles are not blocked in any way as this will cause the unit to automatically stop. If this should occur, switch off and allow the unit to cool

#### HAIR DRYER - CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE


- Unplug the appliance and allow to cool.
- To maintain peak product performance and to prolong motor life, it is important to regularly remove any dust and dirt from the air filter grille and clean with a soft brush.
- To remove the rear grille, for cleaning, hold the dryer handle in one hand, then with the other place your thumb and index finger either side of the rear grille. Pull the rear grille away from the dryer.
- To replace the rear grille hold in place with thumb and index finger again and click back onto the dryer.





### **STRAIGHTENER - INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
- For extra protection use a heat protection spray.
- Hairsprays contain flammable material do not use while using this product.
- Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- 1. Plug the product into the mains power supply.
- 2. Slide the switch, which is located on the side of the product, to the left to switch on.
- Working on one section at a time, run the straightener through the entire length of the hair without stopping.
- 4. Only repeat twice per section to prevent damage to the hair.
- 5. After use, turn the appliance off and unplug.
- 6. To turn off slide the on/off switch to the right.

#### WAND - ADDITIONAL FEATURES

- Multivoltage: for home or abroad. At 120V times and temperatures may vary.

#### WAND - INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
- Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- Use the heat resistant glove to avoid any accidental burns.
- 1. Plug the product into the mains power supply.
- 2. Switch the appliance on.
- 3. Select the desired temperature.
- 4. Start styling on lower temperatures first.
- 5. To increase the temperature rotate the temperature control to the right moving the temperature level indicator towards the top temperature. To decrease the temperature rotate the control to the left moving the temperature level indicator towards the lowest temperature.

#### **TEMPERATURE SETTINGS:**

- 130°C = Lowest temperature
- 200°C = Maximum temperature

#### **Recommended Temperatures**

Temperature	Hair type
130°C - 150°C	Thin / fine, damaged or bleached hair
150°C - 170°C	Normal, healthy hair
170°C - 200°C	Thick and difficult to style hair

Caution: the hottest temperatures should only be used by experienced stylers.

- 6. The indicator light will stop flashing once the desired temperature is reached.
- 7. Use the heat protection glove to avoid accidental burns.
- 8. Hold the handle and wrap the hair around the heated barrel.
- 9. Wait about 10 seconds for curl to form.
- 10. Unwind the wand and release the curl.
- 11. Allow the hair to cool before styling.
- 12. Repeat this around the head to create as many curls as desired.
- 13. Between uses, place your straightener down onto the supplied mat.
- 14. When finished slide the switch down to turn off and unplug the appliance.
- 15. Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away.

#### STRAIGHTENER AND WAND - CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the appliance and allow to cool.
- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.
