IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- Warning: When the appliance is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the appliance is switched off.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Plug your styler into the mains power supply.
- 2. Press the (也) button to switch on.
- Select the appropriate temperature for your hair and the curl you want to create using the +/- temperature control button on the side of the styler. The selected temperature will be shown in the display.
- When the styler is ready to use, and the selected temperature has been reached the display will stop flashing.

Ionic Air Technology

At all times, air flows through the vents on the outside of the barrel distributing millions
of ions to help eliminate static and instantly cool your hair to lock-in long lasting,
smooth curls.

NOTE: The fan will produce a noise when it is operating.

Temperature Selection

 The type of curl created depends on the heat setting and size of the hair section you select. See the below guide on how to achieve different looks, this may vary depending on your hair type.

STYLING TIPS

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
- For extra protection use a heat protection spray.
- Hairsprays contain flammable material do not use while using this product.
- Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- Start at a lower temperature with a small section size and try and experimental curl first to determine the ideal section size, rotation direction and temperature for you.
- When curling the front sections of your hair, curl them in the direction away from your face to frame it. To do this, set the direction of rotation as follows :

If you are right-handed (you hold the styler in your right hand)

If you are left-handed (you hold the styler in your left hand)

For an even more natural-looking result, alternate the curl direction throughout the rest
of your hair.

Creating curls

- 1. Holding a section of hair taught, slide the section into the opening of the split barrel so that the styler is near the top of the hair section (Fig. A).
- 2. Release the hair section then firmly press and release the rotation lever. This will rotate the barrel in the direction selected with the curl direction selector (Fig. B)
- Slowly glide the styler downwards towards the end of your hair without stopping, keeping the speed consistent (Fig. C). If you think you're gliding slowly, go even slower!
- 4. Repeat this around the head to create as many curls as desired.
- 5. Allow the hair to cool before further styling.

For added tension and control

- 1. Lightly grip the cool tip with your free hand as you glide.
- For longer hair, press and release the rotation lever a second time, halfway down the section.

STORAGE, CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away

- After use, press and hold the on/off (b) button to turn off then unplug the appliance.
- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

You means you, the original end-user purchaser of the Goods.

- Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law, or the GGA. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.
- The benefits provided by this Warranty are in addition to all other rights and remedies in respect of the Goods which the consumer has under either the Australian Consumer Law or the CGA. The original purchaser of the Goods is provided with the following Warranty subject to the Warranty Conditions:
- 3. We warrant the Goods for all parts defective in workmanship or materials for the period of five (5) years from the date of purchase (Warranty Period). If the Goods prove defective within the Warranty Period by reason of improper workmanship or material, we may, at our own discretion, repair or replace the Goods without charge.

Warranty Conditions

4. The Goods must be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. This Warranty does not apply should the defect in or failure of the Goods be attributable to misuse, abuse, accident or non-observance of manufacturer's instructions on the part of the user.  (b) Return the Goods to us at the relevant address below or to the Supplier by prepaid freight within the Warranty Period accompanied with (i) the legible and unmodified original proof of purchase, which clearly indicates the name and address of the Supplier, the date and place of purchase, the product name or other product serial number and (ii) this warranty.
- This warranty is immediately void if:
 (a) Any serial number or appliance plate is removed or defaced;
 (b) The Goods have been serviced or otherwise repaired by a person not authorised to do so by us or where non approved replaced parts are used.
- The Goods are designed for domestic use only. A limited 90-day Warranty applies to any industrial or commercial use of the Goods. The Goods must be connected to the electrical voltage requirements as specified in the ratings label located on the Goods.
- 11. This warranty does not cover the cost of claiming under the warranty or transport of the Goods to and from the Supplier or us.
- This warranty is only valid and enforceable in Australia against Spectrum Brands Australia Pty Ltd and in New Zealand against Spectrum Brands New Zealand Limited.
