

Thank you for buying your new Remington® product. Please read these instructions carefully and keep them safe. Remove all packaging before use. WARNING: This appliance is hot. Keep out of reach of children at all times.

## IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been supervised/instructed and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be done by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and cable out of reach of children under 8 years.



Do not use this appliance near bathtubs, showers, basins or other vessels containing water.

- When the appliance is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the applaince is switched off
- For additional protection, the installation of a residual current device (RCD) . having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 mA is advisable in the electrical circuit supplying the bathroom\*.

\* Currently, the fitting in a bathroom of an electrical socket suitable or capable of operating the appliance is not permitted in the UK (see BS7671).

- Burn hazard. Keep the appliance out of reach from young children, • particularly during use and while cooling down.
- Never leave the appliance unattended when it is connected to the power supply.
- Always place the appliance with its stand, if any, on a heat-resistant, stable flat surface

- If the supply cord of this unit becomes damaged, discontinue use immediately and return the appliance to your nearest authorised Remington<sup>®</sup> service dealer for repair or replacement in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not allow any part of the appliance touch the face, neck or scalp.
- Keep the power plug and cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use attachments other than those we supply.
- Do not use the appliance if it is damaged or malfunctions.
- Do not twist or kink the cable, or wrap it round the appliance. Check the cord
  regularly for any sign damage.
- CAUTION: Always remove the appliance from the storage pouch/sleeve before heating and allow it to fully cool before placing it back.
- This appliance is not intended for commercial or salon use.

#### ADDITIONAL FEATURES

- Fast heat up—ready to use in 30 seconds.
- Automatic safety shut off this unit will switch itself off if no button is pressed or it is left on after 60 minutes.
- Multivoltage: for home or abroad. At 120V times and temperatures may vary.
- Styling mat for placing your styler onto between uses.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
- For extra protection use a heat protection spray.
- Hairsprays contain flammable material do not use while using this product.
- · Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- Use the styling glove to avoid accidental burns.

- 1. Plug your styler into the mains power supply.
- 2. Press the on (心) button to switch on.
- 3. When it is ready to use, your styler will beep three times and the display will stop flashing.

#### StyleAdapt Mode

- When first switched on your styler will be in StyleAdapt™ mode 1. The StyleAdapt™ indicator will be fully lit up and StyleAdapt 1 will be shown on the display.
- Working on one section at a time, hold the handle with the cool tip facing down and wrap a section of hair around the barrel.
- IMPORTANT: When wrapping ensure that hair is wrapped around the StyleAdapt™ sensor (Fig. A).
- 3. Wait 10-20 seconds for your curl to form.
- 4. Unwind the hair to release the curl.
- 5. Repeat this around the head to create as many curls as desired.
- Tip: let the curls cool before styling and brushing; this will help to prolong the curls.
- 6. After styling each section, the StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> indicator will spin (fig. B) indicating that your styler is learning about your hair and adjusting the barrel temperature to a heat that is personalised to you. The temperature changes are not shown on the display but happen quickly and automatically during styling.
- NOTE: If the indicator spins when your styler is not in use this just means that StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> Mode is on.
- If you are sharing your styler select StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> mode 2. This ensures that when the styler is used by someone else, it doesn't change what it has learned about your hair. To select, press the <sup>Q</sup> button until **StyleAdapt 2** is shown on the display.

#### **Manual Mode**

- To override the StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> mode and use as a standard styler, press the Q button several times until the display shows the temperture (e.g. 160°C) and the StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> indicator goes off. Note that in manual mode, your styler will no longer be learning about your hair and adapting the heat.
- Select the appropriate temperature for your hair type using the "+" and "--" temperature controls on the side of the product. Start styling on lower temperatures first.
- The "+" button will increase the temperature and the "-" button will decrease the temperature.

#### **Recommended Temperatures**

Temperature	Hair type
130°C - 160°C	Thin / fine, damaged or bleached hair
170°C - 200°C	Normal, healthy hair
200°C - 210°C	Thick and difficult to style hair

Caution: the hottest temperatures should only be used by experienced stylers.

- 5. Working on one section at a time, hold the handle with the cool tip facing down and wrap a section of hair around the barrel.
- 6. Wait about 10-20 seconds for the curl to form.
- 7. Unwind the hair and release the curl.
- 8. Repeat this around the head to create as many curls as desired.
- To re-activate StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> mode press the <sup>O</sup> button until StyleAdapt 1 is shown on the display and the StyleAdapt<sup>™</sup> indicator is illuminated. Your styler will now be learning about your hair and adapting the heat again.
- 10. After use, press and hold the off button for two seconds to turn off then unplug the appliance.

#### **Temperature Lock Function**

- Set the desired temperature using the +and buttons then lock the settings by
  pressing the "–" button for 2 seconds. The for symbol will appear on the temperature
  display.
- To unlock the temperature setting, press and hold the "-" button for 2 seconds.

#### **Memory Function**

• Each time you use your styler it will automatically set itself to the last setting used.

## STORAGE, CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

#### Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away

- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.
