INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

STEP I - Wash and Condition hair as normal

- Squeeze out excess moisture with a towel and detangle hair with a wide-toothed comb.
- Use your normal styling or heat protection spray if you wish.
- If required, use a blow dry spray at the root to create volume or throughout the lengths to create body, bounce and shine.

STEP 2 - Drying & styling techniques - Before attaching the concentrator ensure the dryer is always switched off and unplugged.

- Use the concentrator on a medium heat and speed setting to fully dry the roots and remove excess moisture from the lengths. This will ensure a longer lasting result.
- Turn dryer on and set it to a high heat / high speed. This may vary depending on your hair type. You may need to experiment with a few different combinations before you find the one that is right for your hair.
- Move the attachment up and down the length of the hair until dry. Set the style using the cool shot button

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Cleaning instructions

The air filter should be cleaned regularly. A dirty or blocked filter will impair the efficiency of the dryer.

- To clean air filter, make sure dryer is turned off and unplugged.
- Gently pull the air inlet grille while lifting the filter away from the dryer.
- Use a soft bristle brush to gently remove any particles that are lodged in filter.
- If the unit is dirty, wipe it with a damp cloth.
- To replace the air inlet after cleaning, snap back into place to secure.

Maintenance instructions:

The dryer needs minimum maintenance to ensure the best performance and long life.

- Do not attempt to repair the appliance yourself.
- ▶ Do not attempt to tamper with any of the user-operated controls.
- Keep all intake openings clear of dust accumulation. See "cleaning instructions" above. No other maintenance is required.
- If the cord becomes twisted due to use, periodically straighten it. Store dryer and cord where they will not be damaged. Do not wrap cord around dryer.



When not in use, unplug the dryer. Allow to cool and store out of reach of children in a safe, dry location. Never wrap the cord around the appliance as this will cause the cord to wear prematurely and break. Handle the cord carefully and avoid jerking, twisting or straining it, especially at plug connections.

WIRING INSTRUCTIONS UK Plugs Only

This product is fitted with a BSI363 plug fused at 13A. If the plug is unsuitable, it should be disconnected and an appropriate plug fitted as detailed below. If it is necessary to replace the plug fuse, use only fuses that are approved to BSI362, rated at 13A. If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with following code:

BROWN - LIVE

As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows: The wire which is coloured BLUE must be connected to the terminal which is marked 'N' or coloured BLACK. The wire which is coloured BROWN must be connected to the terminal which is marked 'L' or coloured RED. Never connect either of the wires to the big EARTH terminal marked 'E' or coloured GREEN or GREEN AND YELLOW.
