## **ADDITIONAL FEATURES**

---

- Fast heat up—ready to use in 15 seconds.
- Automatic safety shut off – this unit will switch itself off if no button is pressed or it is left on after 60 minutes.
- Multivoltage: for home or abroad. At 120V times and temperatures may vary.

---

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

---

- Before use, ensure the hair is clean, dry and tangle-free.
  - For extra protection use a heat protection spray.
  - Hairsprays contain flammable material - do not use while using this product.
  - Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
1. Plug the product into the mains power supply.
  2. When your straightener is plugged in but not turned on the lock symbol  will come on to show that it is in standby mode.
  3. Press and hold the on/off button to switch on.
  4. Select the appropriate temperature for your hair type using the "+" and "-" temperature controls on the side of the product. Start styling on lower temperatures first.
  5. The "+" button will increase the temperature and the "-" button will decrease the temperature.

## Recommended Temperatures

Temperature	Hair type
150°C - 170°C	Thin / fine, damaged or bleached hair
170°C - 200°C	Normal, healthy hair
200°C - 230°C	Thick and difficult to style hair

- **Caution:** the hottest temperatures should only be used by experienced stylists.
6. The temperature bars and digital display will stop flashing when the desired temperature is reached.
  7. Working on one section at a time, run the straightener through the entire length of the hair without stopping.
  8. Only repeat twice per section to prevent damage to the hair.
  9. After use, press and hold the off button for two seconds to turn off then unplug the appliance.
  10. Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away.

### Temperature Lock Function

- Set the desired temperature using the + and - buttons then lock the settings by pressing the "-" button for 2 seconds. The  symbol will appear on the temperature display.
- To unlock the temperature setting, press and hold the "-" button for 2 seconds.

### Temperature Boost Function

- For quick touch ups of stubborn, hard to style sections.
- The temperature boost function boosts the temperature to 230°C.
- Hold the "+" button for 2 seconds to operate.
- **Caution:** the highest temperature is not suitable for every hair type. If you plan to use this straightener on the boost setting of 230°C please test on a small section of your hair first.

## STORAGE, CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

---

### Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away

- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

The plates can be locked together for easy storage:

To lock, close the plates and push the hinge lock forwards (towards the plates).

To unlock, slide the hinge lock backwards towards the cord to the unlocked position.

**NOTE:** Do not heat the unit in the locked position.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

---

- Wash and condition your hair as normal.
  - Squeeze out excess moisture with a towel and comb through.
  - Hairsprays contain flammable material – do not use while using this product.
1. Plug the product into the mains power supply.
  2. Select the desired temperature and speed setting using the switches on the handle.
  3. To switch product on slide speed setting switch right once to medium speed setting  or twice to the high speed setting .
  4. To select heat setting slide the temperature setting switch to the low , medium  or high setting .
  5. After use, turn the appliance off and unplug it.
  6. Let the appliance cool down before cleaning or storing away.

## TIPS

---

- For fast drying use the high heat / high speed setting.
- To create smooth styles use the concentrator and a round hair brush (not included) whilst drying.
- To enhance natural curls and waves, attach the diffuser to the dryer. Turn your head upside down and gently place your hair into the diffuser bowl slightly rotating the dryer as you style.

- To create extra volume at the roots of the hair, keep your head upright and place the diffuser against the top of the head. Gently rotate the hairdryer allowing the diffuser fingers to gently massage the scalp being careful not to burn the scalp. Dry gently on a medium heat / low speed setting.  
Caution: Do not use the diffuser on the highest heat setting (☹☹☹).
- To set your style, press the cool shot button whilst styling.

---

## STORAGE, CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

---

### Let the appliance cool down before cleaning and storing away.

- To maintain peak product performance and to prolong motor life, it is important to regularly remove any dust and dirt from the inlet grille.
- To remove the rear grille for cleaning – hold the dryer handle in one hand, then with the other, place your thumb and index finger on the centre piece of the rear grille. Twist anti-clockwise and pull the grille away from the dryer.
- To replace the rear grille, insert the rear grille piece into the back of the dryer and turn clockwise to click into place.

## OVERHEAT PROTECTION



In the event of overheating, the appliance may either stop unexpectedly or start to blow cold air. Overheating is usually caused by a blocked grille/filter. If this happens, immediately unplug the appliance and refer to STORAGE, CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE to clean the grille/filter. If, after doing this overheating continues to happen, stop using the appliance and contact Customer Service.
