ABOUT YOUR DETAIL TRIMMER

Inserting The Battery

Your Remington® Precision Shaver Pack detail trimmer is powered by one "AA" alkaline battery (not included).

- To open the battery compartment, turn the base of the unit approximately 1cm clockwise and pull it off.
- 2. Insert the battery into the unit, positive end first.
- 3. Replace the base and turn it 1cm anti-clockwise to lock it in place.

Battery cautions

- Using non-alkaline batteries will impair the unit's operating performance.
- The battery should not be left in the unit if it is not in use for long periods.
- To prevent battery corrosion, the unit should be stored in a dry environment.
- Dead batteries should be removed immediately and disposed of properly.

HOW TO USE

To trim sideburns

- 1. Turn the trimmer on.
- Gently guide the cutting unit to your sideburns holding the unit horizontally at a 90 degree angle to the sideburns.
- 3. Trim the sideburns moving the trimmer slowly and carefully, to ensure that you do not accidently cut hairs that you do not intend to trim.

Note: It is not recommended that you use the trimmer to define or trim the eyebrows.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Both your detail trimmer and nose & ear trimmer are designed to give you years of comfortable use. To ensure that you get optimal performance from your trimmers, follow these simple cleaning and lubricating tips:

After each use, brush or blow accumulated hair from the cutting units.

Rinsing Your Trimmer

- The head of your detail trimmer is washable and can be rinsed with cool or warm water. Simply twist the attachment head 1cm anticlockwise, remove the head and rinse it under the tap - do not use hot water. Do not allow water into the body of the handpiece.
- Afterward, shake excess water from the cutter head.
- Replace the head in the same position as it was removed, turning it 1cm clockwise until it locks into place.

Lubricating the Cutters

- After rinsing the attachment heads, apply a drop or two of lubricating oil or sewing machine oil to the cutting teeth &/or blades (nose & ear trimmer).
- Don't apply too much oil, or it may spray.
- Finally, point the trimmer down and away from you, and turn it on. This spreads the oil evenly and expels any excess.

ABOUT YOUR NOSE & EAR TRIMMER

Inserting The Battery

Your Remington® nose & ear trimmer runs on one "AA" alkaline battery (not included).

HOW TO USE

Turning On Your Nose & Ear Trimmer

The on/off switch is integrated into the battery cap.

- **1.** Rotate the battery cap clockwise to turn on.
- 2. To turn off, simply rotate the battery cap, counter-clockwise, back to the off position.

Note: Always remember to turn on the trimmer before you insert it into your nose or ear to avoid painfully snagging hairs.

To remove hair from the nose

- Turn the trimmer on.
- Insert the trimmer's cutting unit gently into the nostril.
- Rotate the trimmer in a circular motion around the opening of the nostril.
- For best cutting efficiency, gently move trimmer in and out of the nostril as you rotate the trimmer.
- 5. Do not insert the trimmer more than 6mm into your nostril.

To remove hair from the ear

- 1. Turn the trimmer on.
- Insert the trimmer's cutting unit gently into the outer ear canal opening.
- 3. Gently rotate the trimmer in a circular motion.
- To trim hairs protruding from the surface of the area surrounding the outer ear canal, guide the trimmer around the edge of the ear.
- **5.** Avoid inserting the trimmer more than 6mm into your ear canal.

Note: Do not apply excessive pressure as this damages the trimmer and may cause skin injury.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Your Nose & Ear trimmer is designed to give you years of comfortable use. To ensure that you get optimal performance from your trimmer, follow these simple cleaning and lubricating tips:

After each use, brush or blow accumulated hair from the cutting unit.

Rinsing Your Trimmer

- Your Remington® Nose & Ear trimmer can be rinsed with cool or warm water. Just hold the unit's head under the tap - it is not necessary to remove the head first. Do not use hot water.
- If the trimmer needs additional cleaning, the cutting head can be removed by turning it 1cm counter-clockwise and pulling it off. Then blow out the accumulated hair or rinse it more thoroughly under running water.
- Afterward, shake excess water from the cutter head, making sure that all parts are held together.
- Replace the head in the same position as it was removed, turning it 1cm clockwise until it locks into place.

Lubricating The Cutters

- After rinsing the unit, apply a drop or two of mineral oil or baby oil to the cutting teeth.
- Don't apply too much oil, or it may spray.
- Finally, point the trimmer down and away from you, and turn it on. This spreads the oil evenly and expels any excess.

Power System: Cordless - shaver can only be used without the power cord. The shaver will not run while it is charging.

NOTE: Some countries will require the use of a plug adaptor that is not included with your shaver.

CHARGING

- Before using your shaver for the first time, charge it for 24 hours.
 Note during this charge ignore the electronic indicators as they are in "start-up cycle".
- Plug the adaptor into your shaver and then plug the charging adaptor
 unit into a domestic power outlet. Check to ensure that the shaver is
 OFF. The Charging Indicator Light will illuminate to indicate that it is
 charging. When the battery is full the Charging Indicator will remain
 illuminated until disconnected from the power outlet.
- The batteries cannot be overcharged, but it is recommend that charging be discontinued and the shaver stored away if it will not be used for an extended period of time (2-3 months).
- The shaver will be fully charged in 16 hours.
- To preserve the life of the batteries, discharge them by running the shaver until the shaver turns off. Do this every 6 months.
- Use the shaver only with the charging adaptor supplied.

SHAVING TIPS

 Always hold the shaver at a right angle to the skin so that all three heads are touching the skin with equal pressure

- Stretch skin with the free hand so hairs stand upright, making it easier for them to enter the cutting chamber.
- Use moderate to slow, circular stroking movement. The use of short, circular motions in stubborn areas may obtain a closer shave, especially along the neck and chin line.
- Do not press hard against the skin to avoid skin irritation and/or damage to the rotary heads.

NOTE: As with every shaver, your shave will improve over time. Allow up to four weeks of daily shaving to develop an effective shaving style and for your skin to adjust to the new shaver. The adaptation period might take a little longer if your skin is sensitive, if you are switching from a different method of shaving, or if you alternate between shaving methods.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

DAILY CLEANING

- Open the shaver head by pressing the release button on the front of the shaver (Fig. A) and flipping open the head away from the body of the shaver (Fig. B).
- 2. Tap out excess hair shavings.
- 3. Rinse the head of the shaver in running water.

CAUTION: Never submerge the shaver body in water.

Close the head assembly.

MONTHLY CLEANING

- Perform cleaning steps 1 and 2.
- Hold the shaver upside down so that the open cutter assembly is facing towards you. Slide the blue cutter support frame upwards towards the shaver to release it from the assembly (Fig. C).
- Pull the cutter support frame away from the inner cutters (Fig. D).
- Thoroughly brush hairs from the inner and outer cutters. Rinse out remaining debris (Fig. E).
- Place the cutter support frame back into position and lock into place (Fig. F-G).
- Align the spring hinge into the slot at the back.

WARNING

- Detach the shaver from the power cord before cleaning with water
- Only the shaver head is suitable for rinsing under the tap.

CAUTION

- Do not submerge the entire appliance in water as damage may occur.
- Shaver heads can be rinsed with water. The water temperature should not exceed 70 degrees. Unplug the shaver before cleaning with water.
- Keep the power adaptor dry.















POP UP TRIMMER

Lubricate teeth with oil every six months.

BATTERY REMOVAL FOR DISPOSAL ONLY

Note: The battery is not intended to be removed or replaced under normal use. The only time the battery should be removed or the unit opened or disassembled, is at the end of the product's useful life before it is discarded.

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REPLACING THE HEAD & CUTTERS

It is very important to replace your shaving heads and cutters when necessary to ensure a close, comfortable shave without irritation. We recommend they be replaced every 12 months. Here are some signs of head and cutter wear, indicating that replacement is needed:

- Irritation: As the heads get excessively worn you may experience some skin irritation. This would be especially noticeable when you apply moisturizing lotion.
- Pulling: When the cutters wear you may feel a sense of pulling and a loss of closeness when you shave. This is an indication that it is time to replace your heads and cutters.
